Long delay and medicine shortages

The pharmaceutical industry has warned that patients could face medicine shortages and long delays of new medicines as a result of the European Medicines Agency (EMA) being forced to leave the UK after Brexit

Sky News has been told by drug companies that the EMA's departure will damage the UK's position as a center of drugs innovation and in turn mean patients have to wait for new treatments that currently reach the British market first.

The EMA, which licenses medicines for 500 million Europeans and oversees an industry worth £200bn, has been based in London for more than 20 years, but will leave its Canary Wharf headquarters after March 2019.

Indivior have opened their new laboratory development, which will become the centre for their research operations nationally.

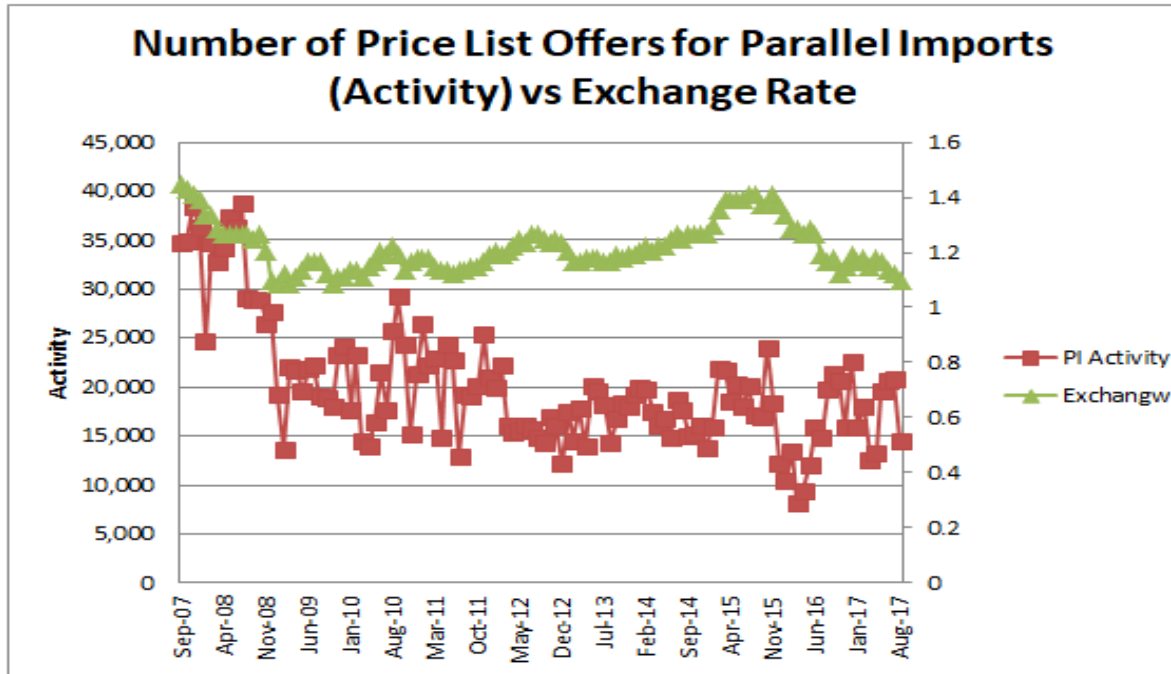
The centre will house research and innovation into drugs that help people battle with addiction.

Parallel Import Activity

Comparing the number of offers for parallel imports which Wavedata have seen in prices lists with the euro to pound exchange rate shows that although there has been some monthly variation in the amount of imported stock being offered for sale, the number of offers has more or less hovered along at between 15,000 and 20,000 offers per month since 2011. This is less than the previous period between 2009 and 2011 when the number of PI offers was just over 20,000, and far less than the period before 2009 when the number of offers as high as 35,000 offers a month. The 15,000 to 20,000 corridor does seem to be with us for the next year or so, but Brexit may change this.

Pregabalin continues to create precedents

Pregabalin continues to create precedents in the UK, following its recent history with ‘carved out’ indications. The authority NHS England advised in June that pharmacists could dispense pregabalin for treating “any condition” from 17 July. Its colleagues in the Department of Health responded by putting pregabalin in category M of the Drug Tariff of reimbursement prices from 1 August, an unusually rapid step, especially one month into a new quarterly Drug Tariff.
