UK pays less for cancer drugs

A report in The Lancet Oncology has found that the UK is paying less for new cancer drugs than other EU countries.

Prices of cancer drugs have increased, placing major stress on many healthcare systems, including the NHS.

Prices can vary, – from 28 percent to 388 percent – between high-income European countries, Australia, and New Zealand.

The pharmaceutical industry says that the UK are getting a fair deal on medicines.

Trade prices for lercanidipine 10mg and 20mg tablets increasing by as much as seven times in November led the UK's Department of

Health to grant a price concession for the lower strength and maintain October's concession for the higher.

Such concessions are granted

when market prices exceed those in the Drug Tariff.
