

# Tolbutamide takes a downturn after highs

Having topped the 'biggest risers' table in December (*Generics bulletin*, 13 January 2012, page 27), 28-tablet packs of tolbutamide 500mg were to be found astride the 'biggest fallers' table in January (see Figure 2). A modest average price decline of 13% last month, however, compared with a 295% rise in December.

Nevertheless, for the first month since October 2011, the product was not granted 'no cheaper stock obtainable' (NCSO) status by the Department of Health (DoH). This allows pharmacists to dispense a more expensive alternative. Instead, the product was listed among those granted special price concessions. Pharmacists were reimbursed £24.56 (US\$38.26) for dispensing the diabetes drug, giving them a dispensing margin of 28% over the average market price.

Another product granted a price concession in January was 28-

tablet packs of nitrazepam 5mg. This reflected the 165% rise in the product's average price, as recorded at the head of Figure 3, and marked the second consecutive month it had been singled out by the DoH. Pharmacists were reimbursed £4.20. This was down from £4.63 in December, but still gave them a 32% dispensing margin. Two betahistine products were alone in having NCSO status in January.

Elsewhere, prices for 'fast movers' were relatively volatile, with numerous double-digit changes in the month. Average prices for the two losartan products in Figure 1 showed the largest gains, closely followed by those for the two venlafaxine products. Minimum prices for the four products were less certain, however.

Price offers were withdrawn for 30-capsule packs of fluoxetine 20mg, and for 28-tablet packs of pravastatin 40mg. **G**
